- Avoid stereotypes.
- Highlight the universal qualities of childhood, and the strength of family and community.
- Are respectful of the child's intelligence, sensitivity, curiosity, and love of learning.
- Have an original text and original story (no folktales or retelling of folktales).
- Unify illustrations and text.
- Display freshness and originality of language and literary expression.

Does the book make you feel YES, ME TOO, NO WAY or WOW? How did this book make you feel? Does it remind you of something special?	Does this book excite you to read or listen to more books about this topic? Does this book inspire you to find out more about a connected topic?	Did the book help you learn more about your world, or community, the people around you, or yourself?
